OTHER FEES (not included in tuition; due July 1, 2020)

Activity/Materials Fee

\$180 per child

• The Activity and Materials Fee helps cover the costs of standardized tests, scoring and printouts; construction paper, copy costs, report cards, records, art and library materials, etc.

Book Fee

\$200 per child

• This fee covers consumable workbook expenses.

Book Rental Fee

\$40 per child 1st-8th grade

• Previously parents have been responsible for the purchase of their child's textbooks. Starting this year the school has classroom sets every subject area except Science. In lieu of purchasing your child's textbooks, we now ask that you pay a book rental fee each year. Parents will be responsible for replacing any books that are damaged or lost.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES:

• Science textbooks according to the student's grade must be purchased before the first day of school (we will send information home to you at a later date); school uniforms; physical education uniform; optional lunch service, field trips.

Financial assistance is awarded to students who attend St. Paul and demonstrate need. You will be expected to contribute to your child's education according to your financial profile. If you would like to apply for financial aid, please apply online through FACTS by May 1. After May 1st, financial aid is open for new families who will attend St. Paul next year.
