

# Supply List - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

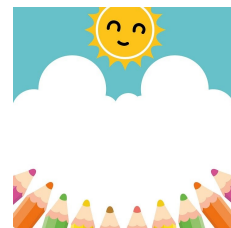

In an attempt to relieve families of any unnecessary expenses following COVID-19, we searched the current school supplies before adding any items to this list. Your child will be provided with: scissors, lined-loose leaf paper, pens, index cards (and other obvious items not included on this supply list). *\*Please label all personal stationery items: binder, pencil pouch (and its contents), ½ sized ruler etc.*

**Thank you for purchasing all of the following important items for your 5th grader:**

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 3 large containers of Clorox wipes (no baby wipes)
- 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 zipper pencil pouch (with 3 holes punched to keep inside binder)→ Please fill your own pencil pouch with the following items:
  - Colored pencils
  - Pencil sharpener (enclosed/with a lid)
  - Colored markers
  - Glue stick
  - Eraser
  - 3 highlighters
  - 3 mechanical /#2 pencils
- Hard-plastic pencil box/case- please fill with colored pencils and markers (this will stay in the cubby).
- 4 packets of #2 lead pencils (with erasers)
- 3 packets of EXPO dry erase markers
- 1 packet of sharpies, fine-tip
- 1 ruler 15cm, to fit in pencil pouch- with metric and US standard measures
- 1 ruler 30 cm- with metric and US standard measures
- 2 inch (or 3 inch) hard cover binder- will be used for all subjects
- 6 subject dividers (to go inside the binder)
- 3 packets of GRAPH loose-leaf paper (Math)- plastic enforced margins are preferable
- 4 folders (no prongs needed): 1. Green (Spanish), 2. Pink (PE), 3. Yellow (Wednesday folder), 4. Blue
- Backpack – **NO ROLLING BACKPACKS**

- \*\*\*Face mask
