## What is the Education Savings Account Program?

Education Savings Accounts are administered by the Tennessee Department of Education. ESA funds provide additional school choices to families who are zoned to a Memphis-Shelby County public school and are income-eligible. Families can use ESA funds toward tuition, fees, books and other educational expenses at participating private schools.

Only 5,000 ESAs available statewide.

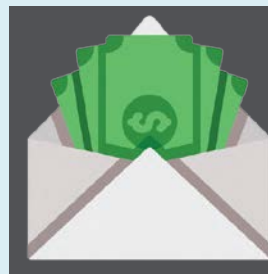
### WHO IS ELIGIBLE
